Opportunity from Fellowship and Caring

We have a group of Junior and Senior High students from Cornerstone Christian School, Lynden, WA, who will be worshipping with us on May 5, 2024. This school is affiliated with the American Reformed Church.

There will be 24 students (7 boys and 17 girls) and 5 chaperones attending. We, as a congregation, have offered to provide the noon meal for them and to spend some time getting to know them better.

ESL Ministry Announcement and Update

We are excited with the success of our ESL ministry; we have 9 students regularly attending. We are running a kids' club at the same time for their children and have 3 children attending. Some of the students have visited our church for Sunday worship.

Online training is periodically available through MNA if the in-person training does not work for you.
